## **Tier Definition**

Tier 1	Primary/secondary schools, general small reference public libraries and museums.
Tier 2	Community colleges, undergraduate or master's-level colleges or universities, independent research libraries, museums with scientific research, small nonprofit or government labs, professional societies or trade associations, local government agencies.
Tier 3	Locally administered, single-site doctorate-granting research universities, medical or pharmacy schools, major teaching or research hospitals, nonprofit research institutes, large public research facilities, small for-profit organizations, small non-profit/government research institutes.
Tier 4	Academic institutions with very high research activity and commensurate usage. Statewide or regional academic institutions. Statewide or regional research institutions. Single organizations or academic institutions, public or private, with more than one site or campus in the same city. Non-profit research organizations or networks. For-profit organizations (single institution with regional campuses, not multi-national).
Tier 5	Large non-profit/government research institutes. Consortia of academic libraries (includes groups of universities that share access or large state-wide licenses). Consortia of medical libraries and affiliated hospitals (includes groups of medical libraries or hospitals that share access). Groups of affiliated labs or regional buying groups, state or national government agency. For-profit organizations. Includes large institutions, mostly pharmaceutical or biotech companies, which have a presence in several countries.
